The Need

Are you ready to bring HOPE to single moms and children in Naples? Children growing up in single-parent families typically do not have the same economic resources and support systems available to those growing up in two-parent families. Compared with children in married-couple families, children raised in single-parent households are more likely to drop out of school, experience teen pregnancy and face divorce in adulthood. Consider that:

- In Florida, there are more than 1.5 million children living in single-parent households.
- There are nearly 280,000 single-mother households living in poverty in Florida.
- In the five counties that surround FBC Naples (Collier, Glades, Hendry, Lee, and Charlotte), there are 82,059 single-parent households.

The Opportunity

One More Child, in partnership with FBC Naples, announces plans to build and operate a single moms campus in SW Florida that will:

- Allow single moms and their children to hear the Good News and experience the good works from the local church.
- Engage church members in serving the fatherless as the success of the program is predicated on volunteerism.
- Strengthen families and society, resulting in fewer children being removed from their homes.

Projected impacted includes:

- More than 100 single moms and children served over a three-year period.
- More than 645 volunteer hours annually through mentors, childcare and home care.
