CONSIDER THESE FACTS:

- There are more than 800 children in foster care and out-of-home care in Duval County.¹
- 33.8 percent of households in Jacksonville are single-mom households.²
- More than 20 percent of children and adults in Duval County are food insecure.³

OPPORTUNITY

FBCH and One More Child will expand its campus in Jacksonville to impact more vulnerable children and struggling families. The campus expansion will occur in three phases:

- PHASE I: This phase has already begun and includes transitioning part of our ministry into newly-acquired building space located off the intersection of University Blvd. and Bartram Rd. This space is undergoing renovations and will be the host site for our employees, as well as for large-scale community trainings and events related to foster care, anti-trafficking, single moms, food packing and more.
- PHASE II: This phase includes the addition of a compassion center (approximately 25,000 square feet) two Foster Family Homes, and three paired villas to serve six single moms and their children (in addition to the two current homes already serving single moms and children on the campus). Planning for this phase has already begun.
- **PHASE III:** In this phase, we will continue to expand our Foster Family Homes and Single Moms program through additional housing on the Jacksonville campus.

PROJECTED 5-YEAR IMPACT

Through our capital expansion, we will have the ability to serve more children and families in Jacksonville than ever before! Conservative estimates indicate that in the first five years after completion we will:

- Serve approximately 30,000 children and families in need in Jacksonville.
- Provide up to 12 million meals to individuals while sharing the love of Christ.
- Engage with volunteers for more than 68,000 hours as they make a direct impact within their own community.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

PRAY: Pray for our staff, the children and families that will be served, as well as generous donors, church engagement, volunteers and community partnerships.

GIVE: A portion of the funds needed for our Jacksonville expansion have already been committed. However, our future timeline is dependent on more individuals, churches, foundations, civic groups and others to generously give. A minimum of \$9.5 million will fund phases I and II. Commitments of more than \$5.5 million have already been secured, and an additional \$4 million is needed to meet all of phase I and II funding.
