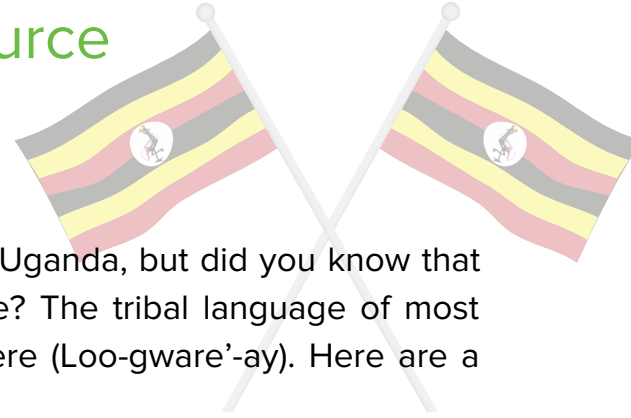

English and Swahili are the two official languages of Uganda, but did you know that there are about 41 indigenous tribal languages there? The tribal language of most children in our sponsorship program is called Lugwere (Loo-gware'-ay). Here are a few fun phrases in Lugwere for you to practice!

ENGLISH	LUGWERE
Hello!	Koiseyo (koh/i/say/oh)
See you later!	Nabawona (nah/bah/wone/a)
Where is the bathroom?	Ekinabiro kiriyaina? (ay/keen/a/beero keery/yie/na)
God bless you!	Katonda akuwe omukisa (kah/tone/da ah/koo/way oh/moo/kisa)
I love you!	Nkutaka (n/koo/tah/ka)
