Each year in the United States, an estimated 10,500 underage youth are coerced into and victimized by the sex trade. At One More Child, we cannot stand the thought of any child enduring the unthinkable trauma of being trafficked. With the compassion of Christ and clinical expertise, we provide care to children and young adult survivors of trafficking, working locally and globally to prevent vulnerable children and individuals from being manipulated into this heinous reality.

COLLABORATION AND TRAINING

We provide 24/7 crisis intervention and ongoing services to sex trafficking victims through our mobile teams, advocacy, mentorship, and mental health therapy. We work tirelessly with schools, medical facilities, law enforcement, the hospitality industry, and others to improve coordinated care.

Child sex trafficking is a nationwide epidemic

Polaris, the United States National Human Trafficking Hotline operator, received 51,073 substantive phone calls, texts, webchats, emails, or online tips about potential cases of sex trafficking in 2021. In 2023, a National Survivor Study revealed that 84% of trafficking survivors endured childhood sexual abuse, 96% experienced various forms of abuse, and 93% confronted issues related to drug use or mental health. There are trafficking victims in your city we cannot reach without your help.
