SINGLE MOMS

Recently, Single Moms program staff celebrated a full-circle moment when they hosted an in-person Single Moms Community Program training. One More Child's Single Moms Community Programs are led by a team of volunteers who facilitate a 10-week curriculum designed to assist mothers on their journey to self-sufficiency.

Not only was this training a resounding success with passionate volunteers sharing their ideas and talents, but a single mom hero was present. A graduate of One More Child's Single Moms residential program, Tomasa's remarkable story is an example of the impact community can make on a family. With the support of One More Child along with her own self-discipline and determination, Tomasa saved \$10,000 during her time in the program, pursued her education to become a licensed therapist, and was able to purchase her very own home.

Today, Tomasa serves at her church and is a testament to the courage and determination of single mothers. Her tearful declaration, "God made this happen!" was a powerful ending to the training session and a reminder of the powerful impact a community of support can have on one struggling family.



SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE

Stephanie's* journey mirrors that of many mothers who seek support at pregnancy care centers when facing the challenges of unplanned pregnancies. Struggling with job loss and financial strain due to her pregnancy, Stephanie felt overwhelmed, and abortion seemed like her only option.
