He had experienced significant trauma and struggled with lying and self-esteem. But the Meltons were committed to providing him love, support, and a sense of belonging.

Zeke experienced many transformative moments during his time with the Meltons. While in their care, Zeke accepted Jesus as his Savior and was baptized.

Before he moved on to his next home, the Meltons threw him his first-ever birthday party. He was nine.

When it was time for him to transition to a new home, Zeke asked his caseworkers to place him close to a church so he could keep attending. It is incredible how the Lord used the Melton family to lead this little boy to Jesus!

As a graduate of our Single Moms residential program, Linda\* has a powerful story of grace, restoration, and hope. Linda shared, "I was at my breaking point. I knew I wanted better for myself and for my children but felt stuck. I prayed, 'God, if you open a door, I will know that is where I'm supposed to be.'

After exploring other options, a door did open for Linda – and it was a door to One More Child's Single Moms residential program.

Over the next several months, she deepened her relationship with God, found her home church, and ended a toxic relationship. Then, doors continued to open for Linda. She landed the job of her dreams. She also saved more than \$14,000 and established a healthy routine with her children.

Linda also dreamed of buying a home. This year marks five years since she moved in.

Today, Linda is a licensed therapist, a full-time doctoral student, and leading a One More Child Single Moms Community Program at her church. She believes God is using the painful parts of her story for His glorious purpose – turning the ashes of her life into beauty!

# Your gift could create a refuge for one more **trafficking survivor**:

In the dark world of sex trafficking, survivors can struggle with emotions of desperation and loneliness. Young victims of sex trafficking are asking the question, "Do you see me?"

One More Child is committed to answering, "Yes, we do."

We stand with survivors and with those who are still trapped in the cycle of abuse. One of those survivors is Tiffany\*.

At the age of nine, Tiffany began to be sex trafficked by her mother. This abuse continued for eight years until Tiffany finally broke free.

One More Child came alongside Tiffany to provide her care, a safe community, and support as she walked through her recovery.

Last year, thousands of students graduated from the University of South Florida. Tiffany was one of them! Tiffany graduated with her Bachelor of Social Work degree and plans to use her education and personal experience to help other survivors in the fight for their freedom.

This is a fight worth fighting, and one worth winning.

At One More Child, we seek to reach one more with the love of Jesus Christ. We often do this by meeting the tangible needs of the individuals and families we serve.


